## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 107TH LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT"A "to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A" to H.P. 1055, L.D. 1332, Bill, "AN ACT Increasing the State Gasoline Tax."

Amend said amendment by striking out all of the 13th line of section 10 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'V. Highway and bridge improvement 2,189,000 2,434,000

VI. Traffic Service 50,000 50,000

VII. Bikeways 130,000 130,000

The funds allocated for traffic services are to be used by the Department of Transportation to continue, as in the past, pavement markings on routed highways in urban areas.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow the Department of Transportation to continue pavement markings on routed highways in urban areas as in the past where communities have requested the department to provide this service, and to provide \$130,000 annually for bikeways.
