COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " ^A " to H.P. 1055, L.D. 1332, Bill, "AN ACT Increasing the State Gasoline Tax."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of sections 9 and 10 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 9. Collection of taxes. No tax imposed by this Act shall be levied prior to July 1, 1975. With respect to internal combustion engine fuel as defined in the Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 2902, this Act shall apply only to such fuel which the distributor shall sell, distribute or use on and after July 1, 1975.

Sec. 10. Allocation of General Highway Fund. Receipts to the General Highway Fund for the next 2 fiscal years, from July 1, 1975 to June 30, 1976 and from July 1, 1976 to June 30, 1977, shall be segregated, apportioned and expended as follows:

1975-76 1976-77 HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION I. Winter maintenance \$ 850,000 \$ 850,000 II'. Town road improvement 1,500,000 1,500,000 III. Special state aid construction 250,000 500,000 --hardship cases IV. Access roads 25,000 25,000 Highway and bridge improvement v. 2,369,000 2,614,000 If in the future any of these highway maintenance activities are not funded by amounts at least equal to the presently

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allocated receipts, then there shall be subtracted from each of the fuel tax rates of sections 1 through 8 effective at that time an amount equal to the respective tax's increase under this Act.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to insure that the increase in the gasoline tax will be allocated for the specifically named activities and to adjust the effective date of this Act due to delay in its passage.
