STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Concerning Membership on the Governing Bodies of Regional Planning Commissions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 4513, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 534, § 4, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§ 4513. Representation

The commission's governing body shall consist of the elected chief administrative officer of all organized units of government within the region served by the regional planning commission.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require the regional planning commissions to be governed by the elected officials. At present the regional planning commissions are governed by appointees who are not required to account to the people periodically.
