## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 107TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1033, L.D. 1339, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Contracts of Teachers with Municipalities."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the 3rd paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'2. Contracts. A contract, other than a contract obtained through properly advertised bid procedures, made by a municipality, county or quasi-municipal corporation during the term of an official of a body of the municipality, county or quasi-municipal corporation involved in the negotiation or award of the contract who has a direct or an indirect pecuniary interest in it is voidable, except as provided in subsection 4 and except that municipal employees may serve as municipal officials or officials of a quasi-municipal corporation, including school administrative units.'

## Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to permit municipal employees to serve as municipal or quasi-municipal corporation officials.
