

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 107TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1033, L.D.1339, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Contracts of Teachers with Municipalities."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. 30 MRSA §2251, sub-§2, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 785, §3, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

2. Contracts. A contract, other than a contract obtained through properly advertised bid procedures, made by a municipality, county or quasi-municipal corporation during the term of an official of a body of the municipality, county or quasi-municipal corporation involved in the negotiation or award of the contract who has a direct or an indirect pecuniary interest in it is voidable, except as provided in subsection 4 and except that teachers may serve as municipal officers.

Sec. 2. 30 MRSA §2251, sub-§4, as reenacted by PL 1973, c. 785, §4, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

This subsection shall not prohibit a member of a city council or board of selectmen from making or renewingg a teacher contract with the municipality in which he holds office.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to except teachers who may serve as municipal officers.
