L. D. 1352, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Payment of Fines by Offers

Amend said Amendment by adding at the end before the  
Statement of Fact the following: 'Such fine shall not exceed  
\$1,500 for any one offense.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to place a limit in the  
case of a fine to \$1,500 for any one offense which is 50% more  
than the limit in existing law.
