SENATE AMENDMENT'A "to H.P. 1072, L.D. 1352, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Payment of Fines by Offers in Compromise From Beer and Wine Wholesale Licensees and Holders of Certificates of Approval in Lieu of Suspension."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of that part designated subsection 6, the following underlined sentence:

'Such fine shall not exceed \$1,000 for any one offense.'
