STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Prohibit the Plugging of Lobsters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 4467 is enacted to read:

§ 4467. Plugging of lobster claws

It shall be unlawful to immobilize the large claw or claws of lobsters (Homarus Americanus) by the use of any wood, plaster or other type of plug, so called.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to prohibit the plugging of lobsters.
