STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Concerning the Installation of Sprinkler Systems in Certain Types
of New Additions to Hotels.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

25 MRSA § 2463, 1st paragraph, as last amended by PL 1971, c. 622, § 85, is further amended to read:

All ~~new~~ hotels or additions thereto constructed after ~~September 23, 1971~~ the effective date of this Act, of any type construction, other than fire resistive as defined in the current edition of National Fire Protection Association #220, Standard Types of Building Construction, having 2 stories or more above grade level, shall be protected by a complete approved automatic sprinkler system.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill will provide fire protection for transients staying in buildings such as hotels, motels, inns or clubs.
