RESOLVE, Providing a Minimum Service Retirement Allowance under the State Retirement Law for Horace Strout of Hollis Center.

Horace Strout of Hollis Center; retirement allowance. Resolved: That notwithstanding any other provisions of law, Horace Strout of Hollis Center shall receive the minimum retirement allowance for 10 years' service as provided under the State Retirement Law.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Present law permits \$100 per month to any person who has 10 years of creditable service but also requires that any part of this time must be membership service rendered after July 1, 1942. Mr. Strout was employed in the Highway Department between 1920 and 1930 and separated before the law took effect and now cannot become reemployed and cannot qualify for this benefit by becoming a contributing member.
