STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Notice or Severance Pay by Employer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

26 MRSA § 625, 2nd ¶, as last repealed and replaced by PL 1973, c. 545, is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

Any employer who attempts to unlawfully circumvent this paragraph shall be liable to pay 3 times the severance pay provided by this paragraph.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide a penalty if an employer unlawfully attempts to circumvent the law relating to severance pay.
