RESOLVE, to Reimburse W. E. Emery of North Anson for Loss of Livestock by Coyotes and Bear.

W. E. Emery; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$70 to reimburse W. E. Emery of North Anson as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for loss of livestock by coyotes and bear.

It is the intent of this resolve to reimburse W. E. Emery of North Anson for a portion of a 1974 claim which remains unsettled due to a misunderstanding by the first selectman of the town.
