SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 418, L.D. 1375, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Certain Provisions in the Education Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting a new section following section 23 to read:

'Sec. 23-A. 20 MRSA §2311, last sentence, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 635, §1, is amended to read:

Individual grants shall not exceed ~~6750~~ \$900 per school year.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to bring the language of the tuition equalization law into conformity with funds appropriated in the special session of the 106th and to ensure that the State receives the increased level of Federal dollars which the appropriation justifies.
