HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1096, L.D. 1378, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Coverage of Newborn Children under Certain Health Insurance Policies and Under Certain Hospital and Medical Service Organizations."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the first and 3rd paragraphs of that part designated "§2318." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'All individual and group nonprofit hospital and medical service organization contracts which provide coverage for a family member of the subscriber shall, as to such family members' coverage, also provide that the benefits applicable for children shall be applicable with respect to a newly born child from the moment of birth.'

'If payment of a specific subscription fee is required to provide coverage for a child, the contract may require that notification of birth of a newly born child and payment of the required fees must be furnished to the nonprofit hospital or medical service organization within 31 days after the date of birth in order to have the coverage continue beyond such 31-day period.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify certain provisions relating to hospital and medical service organizations. Filed by Mr. Hobbins of Saco.

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
