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**AN ACT to Make the Price of Liquor Sold to State Licensees Uniform  
Throughout the State.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

28 MRSA § 451, first ¶, last sentence, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 268, § 2, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section, the commission, with the approval of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration, may reduce the retail price of liquor in one store, but shall not reduce the price of any liquor sold to licensees under section 204 at that store below the price of liquor sold to licensees under section 204 at any other store in the State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Currently the State liquor store at Kittery registers a loss because it sells liquor to licensees at a price lower than the price which those licensees must pay at any other state liquor store. This Act will make the price of liquor sold to state licensees uniform throughout the State.
