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## STATE OF MAINE SENATE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 426, L.D.1392, Bill, "AN ACT to Create a Commission to Prepare a Revision of the Eminent Domain Statutes."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Membership. The membership of the commission shall consist of 10 persons. The Governor shall appoint 2 members of the bar from a list furnished by the President of the Maine Bar Association, one qualified real estate appraiser, one member of the Land Damage Board, one representative of the Department of Transportation, one member to represent the public utilities and 2 members to represent the public generally. The Speaker of the House shall appoint one member from the House and the President of the Senate shall appoint one member from the Senate.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for a balanced membership on the commission.
