STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Relocating the Maine Turnpike Authority Toll Booth
from Augusta to Gardiner.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Relocation of toll booth. The Maine Turnpike Authority is authorized and directed to relocate the Augusta toll booth from Augusta to Gardiner to keep the section from Augusta to Gardiner free of tolls.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to keep the section of the turnpike between Augusta and Gardiner free of tolls because of the geographical closeness of the 2 cities and the needs of transportation between the same.
