STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Provide a Uniform Filing Deadline for Candidates for State and National Office within the State of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

21 MRSA § 492, sub-§ 10, as last repealed and replaced by PL 1971, c. 544, § 66, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

10. **When filed.** Any person filing by petition as a candidate in the general election shall file at the same time and date as provided for a person filing a primary petition under section 445, subsection 9.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide a uniform filing deadline for all candidates for state and national office within the State of Maine.
