HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1129, L.D. 1405, Bill,
"AN ACT to Institute a Fee System for Hospital, Nursing Home
and Boarding Home Licenses to Fund Costs of Licensing."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the
Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 4. 22 MRSA §1820, is amended by adding at the
end a new paragraph to read:

No standards, rules or regulations of the department
pursuant to this chapter shall be adopted or enforced which
would have the effect of denying to any nursing or boarding
home, solely by reason of size, the opportunity to receive
from the department reimbursements based on the reasonable
costs of operating such nursing or boarding home.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment is intended to discourage the Department
of Health and Welfare from preventing nursing and boarding
homes of under 7 beds from going on a cost-reimbursement
system of payment.
