RESOLVE, Providing for Purchase of Copies of Town Histories.

Histories of Glenburn, Kenduskeag, Limington and Popham Beach, Maine; purchase of copies. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$2,419 to purchase copies of certain town histories as follows:

1. **Glenburn.** Fifty copies of "Glenburn, a Town in Penobscot County" by Naida Gallant and Clyde Berry, \$125.
2. **Kenduskeag.** Fifty copies of "Kenduskeag, a Town in Penobscot County" by Erma Winters, \$175.
3. **Limington.** Fifty copies of "A History of the Town of Limington" by Robert Lee Taylor, \$325.
4. **Popham Beach.** One hundred and fifty copies of "One Man's World: Popham Beach, Maine" by James E. Perkins and Jane Stevens, \$1,794.

These copies are to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It has been the practice of the Legislature to encourage the publication of books dealing with the history of towns in Maine and thus preserving the history of the State. This resolve consolidates the purchases of such histories into one resolve and provides for the purchase of a reasonable number of copies.
