COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1118, L.D. 1415,
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Commercial Fishing and the Increase
of Certain License Fees Issued by the Department of Marine
Resources."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated
"§3801." in the 6th line (5th line in L.D.) by inserting
before the underlined word "handline" the underlined words
and punctuation 'spear gun, dip net,'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part
designated "§3801." in subsection 3, paragraph B in the 2nd
and 3rd lines (2nd line in L.D.) by striking out the
underlined punctuation and words ", who are residents of
this State" and by striking out all of subparagraph (1)

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part
designated "§3801." in subsection 3 by striking out all of
paragraph C

Further amend said Bill in section 2 in the 9th line
(6th line in L.D.) by inserting before the underlined word
"handline" the underlined words and punctuation 'spear gun,
dip net,'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of sections
5 and 6 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 5. 12 MRSA §3802, sub-§3, ¶A is repealed and the
following enacted in place thereof:

A. The license fee is \$200.

Sec. 6. 12 MRSA §3802, sub-§3, ¶B is repealed and the
following enacted in place thereof:

B. The fee covers the operator and all crew members.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides uniform fees for commercial fishing licenses regardless of the number or residency of the crew members. In addition, it adds 2 methods of fishing for finfish.
