HOUSE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{A} " to H.P. 1118, L.D. 1415, Bill, AN ACT Relating to Commercial Fishing and the Increase of Certain License Fees Issued by the Department of Marine Resources."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 6 the following: 'Sec.6-A.12 MRSA §3802, sub-§4 is amended to read:

4. Equipment. The commissioner shall set forth in the license the equipment licensed and-the-restrictions-as-to-crew members.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 7 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 7. 12 MRSA §3802, sub-§5 is repealed.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate any redundancies in the existing statutes pertaining to crew members.
