SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 430, L. D. 1417, Bill,
"AN ACT to Authorize the Board of Registration in Medicine
to Conduct Medical Education Programs."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the
Statement of Fact the following underlined sentence:

'The power to conduct and operate or contract with other
agencies or nonprofit organizations for the conduct and
operation of a program of financial assistance to medical
students indicating an intent to practice in Maine, under
which program said students may be provided with interest-
free grants or interest-bearing loans in an amount not to
exceed \$5,000 per student per year on such terms and
conditions as the board may determine.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize the Board
of Registration in Medicine to disburse funds which have been
accumulated from licensure fees of physicians for the
assistance of medical students who indicate an intent to
practice in Maine after graduation.
