**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-FIVE**

**AN ACT to Authorize the Board of Registration in Medicine to Conduct
Medical Education Programs.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

32 MRSA § 3269, sub-§ 10 is enacted to read:

10. Powers. The power to conduct and operate or contract with other agencies, persons, firms or associations for the conduct and operation of programs of medical education and to disburse funds accumulated through the receipt of licensure fees for this purpose.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Registration in Medicine to utilize funds collected from physicians as licensure fees for the operation of medical education programs.
