RESOLVE, Providing a Minimum Service Retirement Allowance under the State Retirement Law for Edward C. Miller of Portland.

Edward C. Miller of Portland; retirement allowance. Resolved: That notwithstanding any other provision of law, Edward C. Miller of Portland shall receive the minimum retirement allowance for 10 years service as provided under the State Retirement Law.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this legislation is to provide Edward C. Miller with a minimum retirement allowance of \$100 a month. Former Representative Miller served in the House of Representatives and as an employee of Cumberland County. The Actuary of the Maine State Retirement System has determined the cost to grant Edward C. Miller his legislative service would be \$7,306 if paid at the present time.
