**AN ACT to Permit Public Use of State Docking Facilities in Casco Bay.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

38 MRSA § 330 is enacted to read:

§ 330. State-owned facilities in Cumberland County

Any state-owned watercraft docking facilities located in Cumberland County, including those facilities on Casco Bay, shall, to the extent possible without interfering with regularly scheduled commercial vessels, be available to the public for use as small boat landing facilities and shall be available at a reasonable charge to any commercial vessel transporting passengers over the waters of Casco Bay.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The bill will allow the public and all commercial passenger vessels to use state-owned docking facilities on Casco Bay. There are presently no other available public fixed landing facilities.
