COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A "to H.P. 1143, L.D. 1437, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Fine for Molesting Traps."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the Statement of Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'12 MRSA §2404 is enacted to read:

§ 2404. Molesting traps

Whoever disturbs any trap or takes any fur-bearing animal from any trap other than his own without the consent of the owner of such trap in violation of the prohibition of the last paragraph of section 2451 shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$200 nor more than \$500.'

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to reallocate the provisions of this Act for more proper grouping of the trapping laws.
