STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Concerning the Use of Coin-operated Telephones.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

35 MRSA § 251-A is enacted to read:

§ 251-A. Coin-operated telephones

Each coin-operated telephone in this State which belongs to any public utility shall be equipped to permit a caller to connect with a telephone operator without the deposit of a coin.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act permits anyone who does not have the proper coin change on his person to use a coin-operated telephone in an emergency, as well as to use a coin-operated telephone to make collect or credit card telephone calls.
