COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " Λ " to H.P. 1157, L.D. 1451, Bill, "AN ACT Prohibiting the Shooting of Hunting or Sporting Dogs."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'12 MRSA §2953-A, as last amended by PL 1971, c. 85, §28, is further amended to read:

, dogs §2953-A. Shooting domestic animals/or birds; penalty

Whoever,-while-on-a-hunting-trip-or-in-the pursuit-of-wild-game-or-game-birds,-negligently-or carelessly-or willfully shoots and wounds, or kills any domestic animals or birds or dogs shall be subject-to-the-penalties-provided-in section-3060 punished by a fine of not less than \$200 nor more than \$1,000, which fine shall not be suspended, or by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or by both. The commissioner, upon receiving a written note of the final disposition, shall revoke or suspend the current license or the right to hunt or the right to obtain a hunting license for a period not less than one year after such final disposition. Nothing in this section shall interfere with a duly authorized officer in the performance of his duties.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment makes the careless, negligent or willful shooting or wounding of a hunting dog a criminal offense.
