HOUSE AMENDMENT " G " to H.P. 1437, L. D.
1452, Bill, "AN ACT to Fund Public School
Education."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section
24 the following:

'Sec. 24-A. 20 MRSA §3717, sub-§3, ¶C, last
sentence, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 783,
§35, is further amended to read:

Such a unit shall be granted the adjustment at
least 2 months prior to its budget meeting, when
possible, upon justification of the need for such
an adjustment ~~and-only-upon-the-condition-that-the
unit-raise-its-share-of-the-funds-required-to
maintain-its-elementary-or-secondary-per-pupil
operating-cost-as-required-by-paragraph-B.'~~
