HOUSE AMENDMENT "K" to H.P. 1437, L. D. 1452, Bill, "AN ACT to Fund Public School Education."

Amend said Bill in section 18 in that part designated subsection 11 by striking out all of the first underlined sentence of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Total major capital outlay expenditures approved by the State Board of Education during any single year shall not exceed \$35,000,000.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the total school construction which may be approved by the State Board of Education to \$35,000,000 per year.
