HOUSE AMENDMENT "M" to H. P. 1437, L. D. 1452, Bill, "AN ACT to Fund Public School Education."

Amend said Bill in section 35 in that part designated "§451." in the 2nd paragraph by striking out all of the next to the last underlined sentence and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The Legislature shall annually, prior to April 1st, certify by joint order the amount which it deems reasonably necessary for the support of public education to the State Director of Property Taxation.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to set up the mechanism for legislative certification of the amount deemed reasonably necessary for support of public education.
