STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Authorizing the County Commissioners of the Various Counties to Expend Funds for the Purchase of Real Estate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 425 is enacted to read:

§ 425. Purchasing of real estate

The county commissioners of all counties are authorized to expend county funds for the purpose of purchasing real estate and other property for county purposes, including the purchasing of real estate and other property from the Federal Government which is deemed necessary for county purposes. Such purchases shall not exceed the limit of the bonded indebtedness of the county.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to authorize the county commissioners of the various counties to expend funds for the purchase of real estate.
