COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1166, L.D. 1465, Bill
"AN ACT Concerning the Transportation of Long Logs by
Combination Vehicles."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the words
"Long Logs" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Tree
Length Logs'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of paragraph B
of subsection 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'B. That the load on such vehicle combinations utilized
exclusively for the transportation of tree length logs
may extend beyond 56 1/2 feet by 8 1/2 feet, provided
that not more than 25% of the length of such logs shall
extend beyond the body of such vehicle combination.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to extend the overall
maximum length of combination vehicles and load 8 1/2 feet
when utilized exclusively for the transportation of tree
length logs.
