COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1169, L.D. 1467,  
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Expediting of Procedures under  
the Municipal Employee Labor Relations Board."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out all of the  
last 2 underlined lines (same in L.D.) and inserting in place  
thereof the following: 'The hearing on said complaint shall  
be held within 30 working days after the receipt of such  
complaint by the executive director.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of sections  
3 and 4.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to expedite the  
processing of complaints by the board without imposing  
unreasonable time constraints upon any of the parties involved  
or upon the board.
