STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Provide Funds for Fishway on the Kennebec River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1976 to complete the building of a fishway on the Kennebec River. Federal matching funds shall be used to complete the project.

Any unexpended balances shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the project is completed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The regular session of the 106th Legislature by P&SL 1973, c. 127 appropriated \$30,000 for this project. The purpose of this bill is to provide funds to complete the project.
