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AN ACT to Increase Salaries of County Officers of York County.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 2, 17th ¶, that part which relates to York County, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 724, § 3, is further amended to read:

York County: County commissioners, \$2,893; clerk of courts, ~~\$8,904~~ \$11,500; deputy clerk of courts, ~~\$5,899~~ \$8,500; county treasurer, ~~\$2,893~~ \$3,500; sheriff, ~~\$10,017~~ \$13,000; register of deeds, ~~\$8,318~~ \$11,500; judge of probate, ~~\$7,791~~ \$12,000; register of probate, ~~\$6,122~~ \$7,500.
