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

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1191, L.D. 1487, Bill, "AN ACT to Aid Small Municipalities to Comply with Statutes Concerning the Protection and Improvement of Air."

Amend said amendment by striking out in the last line before the statement of fact the period and inserting in place thereof the following: provided public health, safety and welfare are not adversely affected by the emissions of this type of unit. In determining the effect on public health, safety and welfare, the Board of Environmental Protection shall be limited to the standards set forth in section 584-A.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to insure that public health, safety and welfare are not adversely affected by emissions from cone burners. In addition, the Board of Environmental Protection is limited to standards enacted by the Legislature when it evaluates the effect of cone burners on public health, safety and welfare.
