CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1207,
L. D. 1500, Bill, "AN ACT Designating Family Day Care as a
Priority Social Service."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by inserting in the 7th line
from the end after the underlined word "Care" the underlined
words and punctuation ', including Family Day Care'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of
the 6th line from the end.

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by adding at the
end of that part designated "§6110." a new paragraph to read:

'Any expenditure of funds for family day care shall not
cause the amount which may be expended for/any other type of
service to decrease below the cumulative fiscal year to date
amount expended as of April 1, 1975 for/such other type of
service.'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in
the 6th line from the end of that part designated subsection 4
the following: "75% for family day care;"

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in
the 6th line from the end of the first paragraph of subsection 5
the underlined words and figures "25% for family day care;"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to assure that including
family day care as a priority social service does not reduce the
amount now spent for any other priority social service.
