**AN ACT to Include the Chairman of the Land Use Regulation
Commission on the Board of Pesticides Control.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

22 MRSA § 1452, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 678, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§ 1452. Board of Pesticides Control

There is established in the Department of Agriculture a Board of Pesticides Control to be composed of the Commissioner of Agriculture, the Commissioner of Health and Welfare, the Director of the Bureau of Forestry, the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, the Chairman of the Land Use Regulation Commission, the Commissioner of Marine Resources, the Chairman of the Public Utilities Commission, the Commissioner of Transportation and the Commissioner of Environmental Protection. The members of the board may appoint agents to serve in their absence. The board shall elect annually a chairman from its own membership and be authorized to employ necessary personnel.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill includes the Chairman of the Land Use Regulation Commission on the Board of Pesticides Control.
