IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Proximity of Stores to Churches and Schools under the Liquor Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

28 MRSA § 152 is amended to read:

§ 152. Proximity to churches and schools

No such store shall be established within 300 feet of any public or private school, church, chapel or parish house, measured from the main entrance of the state store to the main entrance of the school, church, chapel or parish house by the ordinary and most direct course of travel.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this bill to more clearly define the measurement of proximity of liquor stores to churches and schools under the liquor laws.
