STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Adjust the Retirement Allowance under the State Retirement Law for Donald A. Yeaton of Winthrop.

Donald A. Yeaton of Winthrop; retirement allowance adjustment. Resolved: That notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the retirement allowance of Donald A. Yeaton of Winthrop shall be adjusted to \$371.23 per month to compensate for an incorrect estimate on the part of the Maine State Retirement System.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Donald A. Yeaton recently retired as a mechanic store clerk from the Maine State Police after 30 years' service. Mr. Yeaton was quoted a retirement allowance of \$371.23 per month by personnel of the Maine State Retirement System and retired on that basis. After his retirement, however, he received correspondence from the Maine State Retirement System personnel indicating that he would receive \$304.86 per month. Since Mr. Yeaton's decision to retire was based upon the retirement allowance quoted to him and the decrease greatly affected his retirement plans, he now seeks assistance of the Legislature in making an adjustment.
