SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
H.P. 1015, L.D. 1520, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Municipal
Valuation Appeals Board and Procedures for Municipal Appeals."

Amend said Amendment by inserting at the end before the
Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 3. Application. The provisions of section 1 of this
Act shall not apply to any person who is a member of a municipal
valuation appeals board on the effective date of this Act and
shall not be construed to prevent reappointment of that person
to a municipal valuation appeals board.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment exempts from the application of section 1
of the bill any person who is a member of a municipal valuation
appeals board on the effective date of this Act, and ensures
that section 1 of the Act shall not be construed to prevent
reappointment of such a person to a municipal valuation appeals
board.
