COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1167, L.D. 1523, Bill,  
"AN ACT Requiring Employers to Give Employees a Written  
Statement of the Reason for Termination of Employment."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§630." by  
striking out all of the last underlined paragraph and inserting  
in place thereof the following:

'An employer shall, upon written request of the affected  
employee, give that employee the written reasons for the  
termination of his employment.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make the benefits of  
a written statement of reason for termination available to all  
employees, at the request of the affected employee.
