COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1213, L.D. 1527, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for State Reimbursement of Local School Administrative Units which Send Pupils to Secondary Vocational Schools Located Outside of Maine."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last paragraph before the statement of fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'If, in its discretion, a local school administrative unit determines that a student would be better served by attending, on a tuition basis, an out-of-state secondary level vocational school which is closer than a Maine Regional Vocational School, the State shall reimburse that local administrative unit the same amount per pupil as would have been incurred by the Maine Regional Vocational School.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment merely clarifies the wording of the bill.
