STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Provide for State Reimbursement of Local School Administrative Units which Send Pupils to Secondary Vocational Schools Located Outside of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 2356-I is enacted to read:

§ 2356-I. Tuition reimbursement to districts sending students to out-of-state schools

If, in its discretion, a local school administrative unit determines that a student would be better served by attending, on a tuition basis, an out-of-state secondary level vocational school which is closer than a Maine Regional Vocational School, the State shall reimburse that local administrative unit the same amount per pupil as it would have if that student attended the Maine Regional Vocational School, minus the difference in transportation cost.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that the State shall, in certain situations, reimburse local school administrative units which send pupils to secondary vocational schools located outside of Maine.
