COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P.1215, L.D.1529,
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Eligibility of Benefits
under the Employment Security Law."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out
in the 8th line of subsection 3 (7th line of L.D.)
the underlined word "illness" and inserting in
place thereof the underlined words 'good cause as
determined by the commissioner'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to broaden
the reasons for which a person may receive
prorated benefits from illness only for good
cause, subject to determination by the Commissioner
of Manpower Affairs.
