AN ACT to Extend the Statutes of Limitations on Claims under the Workmen's Compensation Statutes where Payments are Made on Account of Injury.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

39 MRSA § 95, first sentence, as amended by PL 1973, c. 788, § 233, is further amended to read:

Any employee's claim for compensation under this Act shall be barred unless an agreement or a petition as provided in section 94 shall be filed within 2 years after the date of the injury, or, if payments have been made on account of the injury, within 2 years after the date of the last payment.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to extend the statute of limitations on claims where payments are made on account of the injury to 2 years after the date of the last payment.
