STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Clarify the Requirements for Voting in Municipal Elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 2066 is amended to read:

§ 2066. Applicability of provisions

Except as otherwise provided by this Title or by charter, the qualification of voters the method of voting and the conduct of a municipal election are governed by Title 21. The qualifications for voting in a municipal election conducted under this Title are governed solely by Title 21, section 241.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of the bill is to ensure that any person who is registered to vote on election day may vote in a municipal election. The purpose of the new draft is to clarify the bill.
