STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Exclude Car Carriers from Being Operated with Dealer Plates under Motor Vehicle Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 29 MRSA § 1, sub-§ 22 is enacted to read:
- 22. Wrecker. "Wrecker" shall mean any motor vehicle equipped with hoisting apparatus and used for towing wrecked or disabled vehicles or for freeing vehicles mired in mud or snow and not used or designed to carry a load other than the weight of the vehicle being towed and tools and equipment used in conjunction with the operation of the wrecker.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this Act to define wrecker to exclude car carriers from being used with dealer plates.
